The Observatory of the City is a new organ of citizen participation in which neighbors voluntarily decide to collaborate and are chosen randomly to monitor municipal action and submit proposals for improvement, including the call for citizen consultations.

The Observatory is in charge of analyzing the municipal action and its public policies to propose areas for improvement and make proposals for action; it is also in charge of analyzing the most voted citizen proposals on the decide.madrid platform. The observatory sets its own agenda, and can request the convocation of public consultations.


